WINE CHARACTERISTICS: Collio Ronco Blanchis comes from the far north-eastern corner of Italy. The area is particularly known for its complex aromatics. Collio Bianco, a white wine whose pronounced aroma and purity of fruit put this district, firmly on the Italian wine map in the 1970s and 80s. The terrain, climate and soil composition allows Collio's white wines to bring out its ripeness, maintain acidity and emphasize its aromatic complexities.

SERVING TEMPERATURE: 50 - 52 °F (10 - 12 °C)

TASTING NOTES: The Ronco Blanchis Winery turns out 4 specially structured and complex white wines: Pinot Grigio, Tocai Friuliano, Sauvignon and the essence of the whites coming from this land: "Collio" A classic expression of the Friulan Lands. Complex and Structured, it elegantly expresses itself the instant it is poured into a glass. Densely planted vines produce a terroir-driven Pinot Grigio, which features a flinty profile with notes of pear and fine mineral. The Palla family composes this wine with passion and tradition into a bottle with unmatched merit. Salient, intense aromas that emanates the fragrance of the land.

INTERESTING FACT: Collio, in Italian, means hillsides.
